

#### **SEAT ALLOCATIONS AND RESERVATIONS**

- Seats are booked on a first-come-first-served basis once booking lines open on 29<sup>th</sup>
  October 2025.
- Once your tickets are reserved, we will send you an invoice via email confirming all the details of your booking. Due to demand, invoices may take up to ten working days to be sent.
- Our group booking procedure applies to groups of 20 or more. If you are booking less than this number you will not be eligible for our group booking benefits and presale.
- You will receive one complimentary ticket in every ten booked
- We do not require a deposit
- Once you have reserved your seats and dining options, you will need to confirm your final numbers and pay for all tickets no later than Monday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2026. If you have not paid in full by this date at 1730 hours then we reserve the right to release your tickets back for sale. Tickets can be paid for via bacs, or over the phone via card. We no longer take cash or cheques as means of payment.
- We must have only one designated contact for your group booking, and we will not be able to discuss or edit your booking with any other members of your group.
